

**DISTRICT OF WELLS
BYLAW NO. 83, 2007**

**A Bylaw to Provide for the Payment of Indemnities
to the Members of the Wells District Council**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Community Charter, the Council of the District of Wells is empowered to provide for the payment of an annual indemnity to the Mayor and Councillors of the District of Wells, a part of which may be an allowance for expenses incidental to their duties;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Wells in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. The annual indemnity paid to the Mayor shall be the sum of SIXTY-FIVE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$6,534.00) retroactive to January 1, 2007, paid quarterly.
2. The annual indemnity paid to each Councillor shall be the sum of TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY TWO DOLLARS AND EIGHTY CENTS (\$2,582.80), retroactive to January 1, 2007, paid quarterly.
3. One-third of such annual indemnity amounts paid to each member of Council shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of his or her office.
4. Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 79, 2006 is hereby repealed.
5. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Council Indemnities Bylaw No. 83, 2007".
